

LEMONS

LEMON FINO



Very large and vigorous tree. Medium-sized fruit, richer in juice than the Verna variety.

High quality for fresh consumption and for the industry.

LEMON VERNA



Vigorous tree with some small thorns.

Fruits in summer, when lemons are rare in European markets.

ORANGES

ORANGE NAVEL LATE



Medium size and elongated shape.

Because of its quality, it is mainly intended for selective markets with high prices.

ORANGE NAVELINA



Large size. Round or slightly oval shape. Seedless.

The most cold-hardy orange variety.

ORANGEA LANE LATE



With the navel hardly visible on the outside. Sweet and pleasant taste. Low limonine content.

Good and consistent productivity.

ORANGE NAVEL POWELL



Large, vigorous tree.
Fruit is large and of excellent quality.
Seedless.
Orange colour.
Fruit shape is round.

ORANGES

ORANGE CARA CARA



Orange with red flesh of medium size. It is distinguished by its reddish interior colour.

It has a high sugar content and a very juicy flesh.

ORANGE MIDKNIGHT



Mutation of Valenica Late from South Africa. Vigorous, thornless tree.

Suitable for both fresh consumption and industrial use.

ORANGE AMARGA



Bitter taste with a more persistent sweetness similar to liquorice.

The most widely grown in the Mediterranean is the Naranjo from Sevilla.

ORANGE NEW HALL

ORANGE VALENCIA LATE



It belongs to the white orange group. Medium to large size.

Suitable for both table use and juice.

ORANGE SALUSTIANA



Medium size.
Flattened round
shape.
Seedless.
Very juicy flesh
and abundant
juice.

Perfect for fresh eating and juicing.

ORANGE SANGUINELLI



Mutation of the double orange fine.
The colour of the segment varies in intensity depending on the piece, but it is not usually red in colour throughout.

CLEMENTINES TANGERINS

CLEMENTINE ORONULES



The fruit is slightly larger than that of the Oronules and more uniform. Attractive, intense reddish orange colour. Good juice content with a pleasant taste.

CLEMENTINE HERNANDINAS



Slightly flattened shape.

The skin is a deep orange colour, thin and easy to peel.

CLEMENTINE CLEMENULES



Good size fruit with a high juice content.

It can be grown in almost all our production areas.

CLEMENTINE ESVAL



Medium-sized, flattened fruit with a deep orange rind.

Very good quality flesh.

CLEMENTINES TANGERINS

CLEMENTINE SANDO



Vigorous, thornless tree. High pollen viability. Very attractive appearance.

Fruit detaches at low temperatures.

CLEMENTINE ARRUFATINAS



Tree of medium vigour with a slightly flattened shape.

Productive variety with good fruit size and rapid entry into production.

CLEMENTINE CLEMENRUBI



Mutation of Oronules. Slightly larger size and very similar characteristics

MANDARINA MURCOTT



Medium size and typical mandarin shape.

High quality late mandarin. Balanced acidity level.

CLEMENTINES MANDARINS

MANDARIN NADORCOTT



Keeps well on the tree until April.

Excellent bright reddish-orange colour; good juice content and easy peeling.

MANDARIN CLEMVILLA



The fruit is of good size and has a high juice content and excellent flavour.
No seeds.

Intense reddish orange colour.

MANDARIN ORTANIQUE



This mandarin tree has an open habit, very long shoots with few branches.

It has no thorns on the thick branches, but on the thin branches.

MANDARIN ELENDALE



Hybrid of mandarin and sweet orange. Medium to large in size and normally flattened.

Smooth textured skin with good deep orange colour.

CLEMENTINES MANDARINS

MANDARIN ORRI



The fruit is of high quality, with a very high sugar content.

The flesh is orange in colour, with a fine, melting texture.

MANDARIN GOLD NUGGET



When the tree is young, the skin is very wrinkled. Completely seedless.

The ratio between sugar content and acidity is perfect.

MANDARIN TANGO



Irradiationinduced mutation of a W. Murcott mandarin graft.


Produces unviable pollen, always grows without seeds.

MANDARIN TANGO GOLD



Irradiation-induced mutation of a W. Murcott mandarin graft.

Unlike Tango, this mandarin contains seeds



GRAPEFRUIT STAR RUBY



Tree of medium vigour and without thorns. Fruits are yellow on the outside. Good size. Almost red flesh. Low pollen viability, very good quality variety.


GRAPEFRUIT RED RUBY



This variety has good internal quality and good shell pigmentation.

In general, it also has very few seeds.

PEACHES

YELLOW PEACH



The skin is yellow with slight pink or orange tones.
They are larger than other peach varieties.

WHITE PEACH



Pêche à chair blanche. C'est une variété sucrée avec une touche croquante.

Elle est très aromatique, avec une peau fine et lisse.

AMANDINE PEACH



Couleur rouge foncé. Parfaitement rond, sans pointe.

Arbre vigoureux, semi-ouvert.

FLAT PEACHES

PARAGUAYO



YELLOW PARAGUAYO



WHITE PARAGUAYO



A variant of the peach with a readish, fluffy skin and a flattened shape.

All varieties have a very sweet taste.

NECTARINES

YELLOW NECTARINE



They have a red or yellowish flesh and a very characteristic sweet taste.

Crunchy texture, thin and attractive skin and good consistency.

WHITE NECTARINE



The skin is not smooth like that of the plum and can be eaten peeled or not.

The flesh is white and the taste is sweet but slightly acidic.

FLAT NECTARINES

YELLOW PLATERINE



Very similar in size and shape to the paraguaya, it looks like a flat nectarine, with a shape that may remind one of a doughnut or button. It has a thin, smooth skin

Very similar in size and shape to the paraguaya, it looks like a flat nectarine, with a shape that may remind one of a doughnut or button. It has a thin, smooth skin

APRICOTS

APRICOT MOGADOR



Early varieties of French type. Round or oval shape.

Orange in colour with a red patch. Good flavour.

APRICOT COLORADO



Like the Mogador. Round or oval shape.

Orange in colour with a red plate. Good taste

APRICOT RAMBO



Apricot early.
Round, oval
shape.
Good firmness.
Vigorous tree.


APRICOT FLOPRIA



Early apricot. Round, oval varieties.

Like the Mogador and Colorado, with a round or oval shape but can be larger in size.







GRAPES

WHITE GRAPE



The vine is a climbing plant with deep roots, which can spread freely up to 30 metres and whose fruit are berries (grapes).

AUTUMN ROYAL GRAPE



Black seedless variety. The berries have a purple to black colour.

The size of the berries is one of the largest of the seedless varieties.

ALEDO GRAPE



Table grape typically grown in the Vinalopó Valley.

A very resistant variety due to its thicker skin and late harvest.

BLACK GRAPE



It needs a warm climate to grow well.

Grapes are thought to have been the first fruit cultivated by man.

GRAPES

ITALIA GRAPE



The colour of the skin is green-yellow with an elliptical profile shape and relatively easy separation from the pedicel. The thickness of the skin is medium.

RED GLOBE GRAPE



The Red Globe grape is known for its large bunches and large berries. This variety bears seeds and has a sweet and appetizing taste.

ITUM 9 GRAPE



Black seedless grape with a very crunchy texture and a neutral-acidic flavour.

The berries are black-purple and oval in shape.

ALMONDS

ALMOND ANTOÑETA



Hard shell, with a strength of 35%.

The inner fruit or seed is usually heart-shaped.

ALMOND PENTA



Balanced growth habit and good disease tolerance.


It is another very late lowering variety but with very good production.

ALMOND AVIJOR



It is a wellproven almond tree under different conditions with excellent results.

It is especially significant is its resistance to ochre blotch.



STRAWBERRYS

STRAWBERRY PRIMORIS



Short day variety with excellent flavour.

The high firmness of the fruit makes this variety ideal for export.

STRAWBERRY LEYRE



Short day cultivation suitable for winter production regions.

Its open plant structure allows easy access to the fruit, which facilitates harvesting.

STRAWBERRY FORTUNA



It is a short-day variety, very well adapted to the climate of Huelva.

Medium to large size, conical. The fruit is firm but always juicy.

STRAWBERRY CALINDA



The calinda fruit is beautiful and uniform, bright deep red in colour.

It is very juicy and has an excellent taste and texture.

STRAWBERRYS

STRAWBERRY VICTORY



Victory, early and very productive, is characterised by its unequalled post-harvest life, which makes it a very safe variety for marketing.

STRAWBERRY ROCIERA



It is unanimously considered to be very complete from all points of view

It is a short-day variety with high resistance.

STRAWBERRY LETICIA



Bright red fruits, uniformly coloured, with a shiny surface. Shiny with a slight violet-cherry tinge.

The berries are oval-conical in shape.

STRAWBERRY GIOELITA



It is characterised by entering into production in mid-January, reaching its highest volumes at the beginning of March.

Very hard fruit, excellent for transport.
